Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- a) How many clinics are located in rural communities?
- b) How many are located in regional cities?
- c) How many are located in metropolitan areas?

Answer:

In response to the Senator's questions, the location of the GP Super Clinics (initial 36 and new 28) have been grouped according to site Remoteness Area Information as per the Australian Standard Geographical Classification – Remoteness Areas (ASGC-RA) systems. The RA categories are listed below:

- RA1 Major Cities of Australia
- RA2 Inner Regional Australia
- RA3 Outer Regional Australia
- RA4 Remote Australia
- RA5 Very Remote Australia
- a) 14 clinics are rated in an RA3 location and two clinics are located in an RA4 location.
- b) 20 clinics are located in an RA2 location.
- c) 0 clinics are located in an RA1 location.
