Written Question on Notice

Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- a) Can you provide the staffing structure and names of the Rural Health division of DOHA, including any changes that have been made since the agreement between the Prime Minister and various independents?
- b) Can DOHA provide a list of rural health organisations that it funds and their contact details?
- c) Can this list include competitive grant round recipients, the subject of funding, their funding timelines and the current disbursement status?
- d) Which organisations have had funding (triennial or otherwise) reduced, suspended or terminated?
- e) Provide a list of all announced, opened, closed competitive grant rounds since 1 January 2008 and note any where delays exist and reasons for those delays

Answer:

- a) The Office of Rural Health organisational structure with relevant contacts is at Attachment A. This structure has not been altered since the agreement between the Prime Minister and the Independent Members of Parliament was made.
- b) A table listing the rural health organisations funded by the Department and contact details is provided at Attachment B. (Note, the organisations included here are funded by DoHA to organise and manage programs on its behalf. Organisations including companies that are contracted directly to provide services are not included).
- c) The National Rural and Remote Health Infrastructure Program is the only competitive grant program funded by the Office of Rural Health. The list at <u>Attachment C</u> details recipients and project payments.
- d) A contract with the Australian Society of Anaesthetists (ASA) to administer the General Practice Anaesthetist Locum Scheme (GPALS) was terminated by mutual agreement in October 2010.

e) The National Rural and Remote Health Infrastructure Program is the only competitive grant program funded by the Office of Rural Health.
