Written Question on Notice

Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- a) For the 2011 placements, how many will be in public hospitals, private hospitals, and other settings?
- b) How many of the additional new placements were awarded to public hospitals, private hospitals and other settings?
- c) Could we get the above information by state?

Answer:

- a) Of the 517 posts selected for funding in the 2011 academic year, 222 are in the public sector, 148 in the private sector and 147 are in posts which are a mixture of public and private, ie. the trainee may rotate from one sector to another.
- b) The Commonwealth Government has selected 152 new posts for funding in the 2011 academic year under the Specialist Training Program. Of these, 96 are in the public sector, 17 in the private sector and 39 are in posts which are a mixture of public and private.
