- e) The HHF Advisory Board assessed whether or not applications met the HHF evaluation criteria and guiding principles. In making its assessments, the Board drew on advice from the Department, which employed a numerical scoring system, and in the case of the Regional Cancer Centre Round, on the advice of experts (see E10-113). The Department's scoring system reflected provisional assessments of the extent to which individual applications met or did not meet the evaluation criteria and guiding principles, and did not reflect competitive or allocative rankings.
