# Community Development Employment Projects and Indigenous Employment Programs- IEP placements

Can you please provide figures for the last two financial years on the number of IEP placements, and the success rates for placements and key milestones (as against previous IEP contract periods)?

### **Answer**

Table 1 shows the number and the success rates for employment commencements and key milestones for the Tailored Assistance and Indigenous Wage Subsidy (IWS) elements of the Indigenous Employment Program (IEP). These two elements account for about 87% of employment commencements in 2009/10 and 2010/11 and now have comparable outcome data.

The key milestones for these projects are that people placed into a job are still in employment 13 and 26 weeks after they started work.

The drop in the rate of achieving 26 week milestones for the 2010/2011 cohort is most likely to be a result of data lag. Many contract holders only submit invoices periodically or wait until all of their participants have completed their placements, not immediately after a participant achieves a milestone. The department's database can only be updated after these claims have been processed.

The key milestone for these projects is how many people complete the training they start.
