Senator Fifield asked:

How many FaHCSIA staff are permanently based, or are resident, in the APY lands or within a reasonable proximity to APY lands.

Answer:

As of 1 November 2011 there are four FaHCSIA staff permanently based in the APY Lands:

1. 1 Anangu Engagement Officer (part-time) located in Amata
2. 1 Government Business Manager (Amata)
3. 1 Government Business Manager (Mimili)
4. 1 Anangu Engagement Officer (full time) located in Mimili, is currently being recruited.
