Has the department allocated any administered funding to support measures under the Stolen Generations Working Partnership? If not, why not?

**Answer:**

The Stolen Generations Working Partnership is primarily about engaging the Stolen Generations organisations and relevant Government agencies to address issues by working in partnership. The Department organises and facilitates biannual forums and interagency meetings that create an opportunity to address issues raised. All members of the partnership are encouraged to pursue resolution to issues raised through ongoing direct contact with the relevant agency or organisation.

A number of specific projects under the Stolen Generations Working Partnership have been supported through the Indigenous Community Strategic Investment Fund.
