Please provide the complete list of Indigenous programs by portfolio, including funding.

### **Answer:**

Information on Indigenous specific program expenditure is available in the Australian Government Indigenous Expenditure (AGIE) tables in relevant portfolio budget statements and also in annual reports.

The AGIE collection is the sum of departmental and administered expenditure from the following:

- Indigenous specific program expenditure (ISPE), taken as expenditure on programs agreed by the Government specifically and separately for the benefit of Indigenous people; and
- Indigenous specific mainstream expenditure (ISME), derived from mainstream programs that target a broader (generally community wide) base but from which funding has been specifically directed to Indigenous specific purposes.

Links to portfolio budget statements and annual reports for 2010-11 are provided in the attached table.

The total actual AGIE in 2010-11 is \$4,042,389,000.
