With regard to CASA requirements: Please provide contractual details with regards to reworking the power - who was responsible for that. Did the Government pay for the reworking - or was it the Alliance partners? How did you come to that arrangement?

Please provide advice on whether there are any issues with the airstrip in relation to housing works in Maningrida.

## **Answer:**

There has been no re-working of power in Maningrida. There has been no re-works or change to the design since commencement of construction. As there was no re-working of the power, no payment for rectification is required by the Government or the Alliance partners.
