**Senator Payne** asked:

Can you please provide figures around the success rates for negotiated targets for employment and training outcomes under CDEP?

**Answer:**

The success rates for negotiated targets for employment and training outcomes under CDEP across the last financial year (2010-11) were, for employment 64.3% and for training 52.2%. The success rate across the prior financial year (2009-10) was, for employment 83.7% and training 33.7%. The lower than anticipated training outcomes is due to initial implementation issues associated with changes to the program and that there was no benchmark from which to base the targets.
