### Answer:

- a) 1. \$19,547,224.
  - 2. At this stage of the financial year it is not possible to accurately estimate whole-of-year expenditure.
- b), c) 1. The 2010-11 DHS standard staff air travel spend comprised: DHS (excluding CRS Australia): \$ 3,186,914; CRS Australia: \$946,721; Centrelink: \$12,640,443; and Medicare Australia: \$2,773,146.
  - 2. As the former agencies of Centrelink, DHS (which includes CRS Australia and the Child Support Program) and Medicare Australia integrated to form DHS on 1 July 2011, there is no longer a meaningful breakdown of travel expenditure by program.
