Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

When was the Department of Health and Ageing first aware that the NSW Government were planning to build a HealthOne clinic in Raymond Terrace with similar objectives to the GP Super Clinic Program?

Answer:

The Department has been aware of the NSW Government's HealthOne Program since approximately 2009. The Commonwealth and the NSW Governments have announced a collaborative approach to the development of a GP Super Clinic/HealthOne facility in Raymond Terrace which will provide an extended range of private and public health care services to the local community.
