**Senator Furner** asked:

Please provide a state-by-state breakdown of the locations of dwellings that have been completed under A Place to Call Home.

**Answer:**

The attached table provides a state by state breakdown of dwellings that have been completed under A Place to Call Home as at 30 November 2011. Dwellings have been broken down by postcode as legal advice is that suburb locations could identify vulnerable people including those escaping domestic and family violence. Victoria has declined to provide any specific locations for this reason.

Tasmania is currently constructing a Common Ground facility under A Place to Call Home in Hobart which will house 25 people however this is due for completion in early 2012.
