* This table does not include Victoria and Tasmania. The Victorian Government declined to provide locations due to safety issues relating to identifying the dwelling locations for vulnerable people and those escaping domestic and family violence. This is in line with the requirements of the National Partnership Agreement on Homelessness. Tasmania is currently constructing a Common Ground facility under A Place to Call Home in Hobart which will house 25 people however this is due for completion in early 2012.
