Senator Siewert asked:

How long do people stay on income management after they have been through the Family Responsibilities Commission process? Provide an average time.

Answer:

The average amount of time for people to stay on income management after going through the Family Responsibilities Commission process is 31 weeks.

Note: this is based on data as at 24 June 2011 and is calculated on the number of weeks for current individuals only and the number of weeks for their latest notice only.
