**Senator Payne** asked:

Can you please outline the number of staff, indicating the APS level and location, your department has engaged directly on matters falling under the housing outcomes (including, separately, Indigenous housing) and, if possible, the number of full time equivalent positions engaged indirectly on housing outcomes.

**Answer:**

As at 31 October 2011, the Department had a total of 174.94 full time equivalent (FTE) positions engaged directly on housing outcomes. This includes 86.25 FTE engaged in Remote Indigenous housing. The breakdown of the FTE by APS level and location was:
