Minister visits around Australia

Senator PAYNE: I assume you would have to take this on notice: is it possible to indicate the commitments the minister has had since her appointment to Indigenous employment and economic development on those issues and locations around Australia please? Ms J Taylor: I am sorry, Senator, I am not understanding what you are asking. Senator PAYNE: The places where the minister has gone to make specific announcements on aspects of the Indigenous employment and economic development portfolios and, I assume, to consult with communities in that process. Ms J Taylor: I can take that on notice. It would be a question for the minister. Senator PAYNE: Thank you.
