Senator Siewert asked:

How many houses refurbished under SIHIP in the Northern Territory have not been placed under tenancy agreements, by community?

Answer:

The Northern Territory Department of Housing has advised that at 30 September 2012, 158 of the 2,053 houses refurbished under the SIHIP/NPARIH in the Northern Territory have not been placed under tenancy agreements.

The 158 consists of:

- Five refurbishments at practical completion awaiting handover from the Alliance to the Northern Territory Department of Housing
- 68 clients undergoing Intensive Tenancy Support, who will then sign a tenancy agreement
- 73 handed over but with Occupancy Information Document only (does not fully meet *Residential Tenancies Act* and requires further works to become compliant)
- 12 with ongoing lease negotiations in Acacia Larrakia. The Northern Territory Department of Housing is working with the community to negotiate land tenure agreements.

The breakdown per community is provided in the table below.
