Is it the Department's view that it is a proper use of Northern Land Council funds provided by the Commonwealth to campaign against the creation of a new land council? If it is not a proper use of those funds, what action would the department take?

The Northern Land Council was invited to make a submission to the enquiry on the application to establish the Katherine Regional Land Council conducted by the former Aboriginal Land Commissioner, the Hon Howard Olney AM QC.
