**Senator Scullion** asked:

As well as receiving funding from IBA, Lhere Artepe Enterprises received around \$6m from ABA. One of the conditions of that funding was that an alcohol management plan would be put in place. The Department advised that the plan has not been implemented. Can you provide a copy of the plan? Also provide details of those measures of the plan that have been implemented?

**Answer:**

A copy of the Lhere Artepe Enterprises Supermarkets Pty Ltd Alcohol Management Strategy was previously provided to the Committee on 25 July 2011 and in answer to a Question on Notice from the Supplementary Estimates Hearings held on 19 October 2012 (**CA60**). A further copy is at **Attachment A**.

Measures implemented by Lhere Artepe Enterprises Supermarkets Pty Ltd include the removal of cask wine, introduction of a floor price for wine and provision of education material in the bottle shops.
