Senator Boyce asked:

Have any concerns been raised with the department about how the centres are operating? If so, what are those concerns and how have they been addressed?

Answer:

PY Ku Centres play an important role in the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Lands, providing residents with a central point of access to services including Centrelink, Job Services Australia, South Australian Government services and Australia Post.

The Department is working with the South Australian Government and relevant Australian Government Departments to place the PY Ku Centres on a sustainable footing.
