#### **Question:**

Part 5.3 of the *Social Security Act 1991* sets out methods of recovery of social security debts. What is (a) the number of debts, and (b) what is the total amount of those debts, on a State and Territory basis, recovered under each of the following Sections for the last two years:

- 1) deductions from debtor's pension, benefit or allowance;
- 2) deductions from debtor's farm household payments or support;
- 3) legal proceedings;
- 4) garnishee notice;
- 5) arrangement for payment of debt;
- 6) deductions by consent from social security payment of person who is not a debtor; and
- 7) using a private debt collection agency.

#### **Answer:**

The information tables at Attachment A provide details of the source of debt repayments for Centrelink payment debts for 2010-11 and 2011-12 financial years.

- 1) Deductions from debtor's pension, benefit or allowance is included under the column *Withholdings (excluding third party withholdings)*.
- 2) Information regarding deductions from Farm Household Payments or Support is not available.
- 3) Repayments as a result of legal proceedings are not reported within a discreet category as the actual repayment can be made through a variety of repayment methods. Information regarding debts recovered through legal proceedings has been tracked since 1 November 2011 and is shown in the table below. Between 1 November 2011 and 31 October 2012:
  - a. The Department has recovered or attempted to recover 48 debts with a total value of \$2,098,851.61 through the use of legal proceedings.

- b. The total amount of recovery in relation to those debts is \$823,925.27. Of the 48 debts, 30 debts have outstanding balances.

- 4) Debt repayments through garnishee notice are shown in two columns *Garnishee through the ATO* (Australian Taxation Office) and *Other Garnishee repayments*.
- 5) Arrangement for repayment of debt is shown in the column *All other repayments*.
- 6) Deductions by consent from social security payment of a person who is not a debtor is in the column headed *Third Party withholdings*.
- 7) Repayments made through a private debt collection agency are shown in the *Collection Agent recoveries* column.
