Question:

a) The Area News in Griffith reported in June that 'a number of local Centrelink clients had been sent letters confirming they were eligible for the \$1,000 one-off government flood grant and the money had been paid into their bank accounts.

- b) However, the clients had never applied for the grants, nor had they received any money and the accounts listed were not their own.
- c) What actions have Centrelink taken in relation to this matter since June? Have the culprits been found?
- d) Has anyone been charged with fraud?
