# Question:

What actions would need to be taken for an AHS being able to obtain an Approval to Supply PBS medicines to its clients using a Section 94 Approval – normally restricted to hospitals?

#### Answer:

For an Aboriginal Health Service to be considered for an Approval to Supply PBS medicines to its clients using a Section 94 Approval under the *National Health Act 1953*, the AHS would need to be declared as a hospital by the Minister of Health and Ageing, under Section 121-5(6) of the *Private Health Insurance Act 2007*.
