Does the Department consider that the mindhealth connect website has met expectations, underperformed, or exceeded expectations? Please give reasons for response.

Answer:

As outlined in its e-Mental Health Strategy, the Australian Government anticipated that the mindhealth connect website would be operational in July 2012, with further functionality and additional services to be added over the next year. The mindhealth connect website was operational on 29 June and formally launched on 5 July 2012, and the Department of Health and Ageing considers that it has met expectations with 48,102 unique visitors as at 30 October 2012.
