Senator Cash asked:

"With respect to the Reimbursement to Great Southern Rail for Concessional Fares: a. Of these payments, how many were made for customers who are:

- i. Recipients of a pension (please provide a breakdown of the type of pension payment received);
- ii. Commonwealth Seniors Concession Card holders?"

Answer:

The number of passengers using Great Southern Rail services in 2011–12 is as follows:

- Pensioner Concession Card holders **31,164**, which includes:
 - Pensioners 29,055 (Age Pension, Disability Support Pension, Paid Parenting(Single) and Carer Payment)
 - o Veteran pensioners 1,954
 - o Blind pensioners 155
- Commonwealth Seniors Health Card holders 3,364

A further breakdown of passengers by pension type is not readily available without the use of significant resources.
