Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

In relation to the Seniors Supplement; can you please provide the following information: (a) A breakdown of recipients into categories (eg, those on DVA Gold Card)? (b) The number of recipients who receive a single payment? (c) The number of recipients who receive couple payments? (d) How many recipients received the payment for 'illness', 'separated', 'in respite care', or 'have a partner in prison'?

Answer:

- (a) As at October 2012, the people who had received a recent Seniors Supplement payment were:
 - FaHCSIA CSHC holders 291,697;
 - DVA CSHC holders 6,117; and
 - Certain DVA Gold Card holders 27,523.
- (b) Approximately 25% of these received the single rate.
- (c) Approximately 75% of these received the partnered rate.
- (d) Data on the number of recipients who were separated due to illness, respite care or partner is in gaol is not readily available without the use of significant resources.
