For those whose claims for DSP were rejected on Program of Support grounds so far this calendar year, please provide, broken down according to the month in which their claim was rejected, their current (most recently available) status, including income support payment received (if any) and whether they are still undertaking a Program of Support.

#### **Answer:**

For claims rejected on Program of Support (POS) grounds from 1 January 2012 to 30 September 2012:
