## **Senator Boyce** asked:

How will reductions in air travel spending be achieved? What is the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates? What restrictions will be implemented for business flights? What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?

## **Answer:**

Reductions in air travel will be achieved through increased use of technology such as video conferencing.

Savings over the forward estimates are not known.

The class of air travel for non-SES staff is generally Economy Class travel. SES officers travel Economy Class between Canberra and Sydney and Canberra and Melbourne (where those cities are the end destination), unless there are medical reasons for utilising a different class of travel. This is a Whole of Australian Government approach. In addition, FaHCSIA encourages SES employees to travel Economy Class where it is practicable.

Savings over the forward estimates are not known.
