Senator Boyce asked:

How much has been spent on printing this financial year to date? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?

Answer:

In the financial year 2012-13, as at 30 September 2012, the Department has spent \$309,739 (GST exclusive) on publishing and printing. This includes printing by the Social Security Appeals Tribunal.

The figure includes all centrally recorded printing and does not incorporate any printing conducted outside of the centralised process.

Information on how much of this was spent on printing documents is not readily available without the use of significant resources.
