**Footnotes**

1. An income unit comprises a single person (with or without dependent children) or a couple (with or without dependent children). Single social security recipients living together in the same household are regarded as separate.
  2. One member of a couple is treated as the reference person for the income unit, based on the type of payment they receive. The general order of priority is Pensions, Allowances, Family Tax Benefit (FTB). An income unit will be reported as receiving Parenting Payment (partnered) if their partner is not receiving another social security payment. They will only be reported as receiving FTB Part A if neither receives a social security payment.
  3. An income unit is classified as Indigenous if at least one partner in the unit has indicated to Centrelink that he/she identifies as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. Where information about Indigenous recipient is provided, the following advice: It is optional for individuals to identify as Indigenous. These data may therefore represent an undercount.
  4. As at fortnight ending 7 September 2012.
  5. Other includes payments such as Bereavement Allowance, Sickness Allowance, Special Benefit, Widow Allowance, Emergency Circumstance Payment, etc and individuals with regular care children between 14% and 35% eligible for Rent Assistance.
  6. Australian total includes income units in other territories and unknown addresses.
  7. A recipient is in housing stress if their rent (after rent assistance) is more than 30 percent of their income. A small number of income units are excluded from housing stress calculations so totals in this table may be lower than those in other tables.

  9. Income units with eligible RA children aged 16 to 19 have been included for the first time in the child counts when working out income unit type from September 2012. This is due to a change to FTB eligibility on 1 January 2012.
