The Blue Mountains Bushfire Recovery Centre is asking for all residents that have had their property damaged or destroyed to please **call and register** at the Blue Mountains City Council on 4723 5000.

Fire & Rescue NSW Impact Assessment Teams have been undertaking assessments of the fire damaged property. Bushfires cause significant structural damage to buildings making them unstable and extremely dangerous to move around in. Wall and roof collapses can occur, as well as falling trees and branches that have been fire affected. The other risk is asbestos.

Safety is still our number one concern and it is crucial that the residents ring Council to get the information and help they need to make sure their property is safe to enter. Properties that have been assessed as posing a health and or safety risk have been clearly marked. With 210 properties destroyed and 109 damaged, it's important we inform impacted residents of the health and safety issues on their property as quickly as possible.

If you know of someone who has had their property damaged or destroyed please get them to call the Blue Mountains City Council on 4723 5000 (seven days).

A community meeting will be held this evening to discuss the recovery efforts and provide important information that residents need to know about health and safety. Please arrive at 6.30pm for a 7.00 pm start at Winmalee High School, High School Drive, Winmalee.

A reminder that the **Recovery Centre** is up and running at the Presbyterian Hall, 158 Macquarie Road in Springwood. A one stop shop for the community and workers affected by the bushfires, I encourage anyone in need of help to drop by. 

This Sitrep covers the Welfare Services Functional Area response to the bushfires burning in various locations.

IMPACT

As requested by the NSW RFS the Welfare Services Functional Area has opened 15 evacuation centres in the last 48 hours across NSW. Currently 3 of these centres are still in operation to assist displaced residents affected by these fires.

Evacuation Centres are currently open at:

- Lithgow
- Springwood
- Swansea

These centres are being managed by Family and Community Services, supported by Community Partners Red Cross, ADRA, Salvation Army and Anglicare as well as the NSW Disaster Recovery Chaplaincy Network. Many details of evacuee registrations and staffing numbers at these centres are unknown at this point due to the dynamic nature of their operation.

PLANS

- Disaster Welfare Services to continue to monitor and provide assistance to the Districts in their response as required.
- Disaster Welfare Services have deployed Alumni staff to Springwood, Lake Macquarie and Raymond Terrace to commence Personal Hardship and Distress assistance to those impacted by these events.
- DWS Planning Officer currently in Springwood to scope welfare services support for transition to recovery.
- Evacuation centres in Springwood, Lake Macquarie and Lithgow are to remain open over the weekend to provide information about welfare assistance available and conduct initial assessments regarding grants, as required.
- The DWAL remains open 8.30-4.30 over the weekend.
- Consultation will occur on 21 October with local human service agencies, including FACS, in affected communities regarding needs assessment and linkages to recovery committees.

POTENTIAL ISSUES

- DWS notes the potential for further fire activity over coming days and has rostering in place to support a Welfare Services FA response as required. A Liaison Officer will remain in place at RFS State Operations as required.
- Increase in calls to the Disaster Welfare Assistance Line as the affected gain access to their property and assess damage. Promotion of the assistance line number is occurring locally in the affected communities but also through the website and RFS social media feeds.
