Answer:

The funding received for Placed Based Income Management from July 2011 to June 2014 is:

- 2011-12 \$8.845 million;
- 2012-13 \$15.376 million*; and
- 2013-14 \$14.348 million* (current budget).
 - * This includes money that has been used to fund other Income Management deliverables as follows:
 - an extension of income management to the APY lands;
 - a change to service offer for New Income Management (NT);
 - minor improvements to the Vulnerable measure; and
 - extension of income management to the Ngaanyatjarra Lands and to Laverton Shire.
