Senator Ludwig asked:

a) How many staff reductions/voluntary redundancies have occurred from 7 September 2013 to date? What was the reason for these reductions? b) Were any of these reductions involuntary redundancies? If yes, provide details.

Answer:

a) Since 7 September 2013 to date (21 November 2013) there have been 125* separations from DSS. Of these 45 have been the result of a voluntary redundancy, the table below details the other forms of separation.

Age Retirement	2
End of Non-Ongoing Contract	26
Promotion/Transfer to Another APS Agency	14
Resignation	30
Transfer back (end of secondment)	8
Voluntary Redundancy	45
Total	125

b) There have been no involuntary redundancies in DSS over the period 7 September 2013 to date.

*These figures do not include any new staff transferred under the partially completed Machinery of Government changes.
