Senator Siewert asked:

How many people have exited the program, and a breakdown as to whether the exit was due to entering work, or study , or other reasons.

Answer:

Since the beginning of Income Management, there have been 20,510 exits from Income Management. People may exit income management because they no longer receive income support, they may enter the workforce or leave the income management area. People may also choose to end their Voluntary Income Management agreement. Data is not collected on the range of reasons.
