As per the discussion (page 62 of Thursday's transcript) please provide a breakdown of HACC service providers for 2012-13. Please provide a list of the successful HACC funding providers by state for 2013-14. Have successful providers been notified? When will they be notified? When will this be announced? Which regions have Medicare Locals assumed service delivery for? How much HACC funding is provided by region?

Answer:

The number of Commonwealth HACC Service Providers for 2012-13, with a breakdown by state and territory, is provided below:

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Two Medicare Locals were also successful through the 2013 Commonwealth HACC funding round. West Moreton-Oxley Medicare Local Limited will receive funding to deliver new services in the West Moreton/South Coast region and Medicare Local Northern Territory will receive funding to deliver new services in the remote region of the Northern Territory.
