**Answer:**

Where the Department of Health has possession of documents obtained or created with input from other departments or agencies consultation will occur in accordance with the provisions of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982*.

- a) Those departments and agencies relevant to the nature and scope of the request.
- b) Prior to the decision being made.
- c) In accordance with usual government practices and procedures for the handling of documents, taking account of any sensitivities or classification of documents.
