 - 6) What was the average amount involved?
- d) For 2013-14, what is the percentage of those convicted for social security fraud of the total number of income support recipients over the period (in number and percent)?
- e) For each year since 2003-04, provide:
 - 1) How many Centrelink recipients referred for prosecution to the CDPP?
 - 2) How many of these were prosecuted by the CDPP?
