Senator Ludwig asked:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

1. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
 - (a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
 - (b) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
2. How much has been spent on departmental stationery requirements to date.
3. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

1. The Department has spent \$7,017.74 (GST exclusive) on office supplies from 1 June to 30 September 2014. The items provided to the offices include: paper, office supplies and stationery.

Approximately 13 reams of paper have been supplied to the Ministers' Offices.

2. The stationery spend for the Department from 1 June to 30 September 2014 was \$193,630.85 (GST exclusive).
3. From 1 June to 30 September 2014 the following customised stationery has been provided to Minister Andrew's Office (cost is GST exclusive):

Date requested – July and September 2014

Date provided – July and September 2014

Cost: \$2,316.16
