**Senator Brown** asked:

In 2014-15 Budget Paper No. 2, the save associated with this measure was \$2.6 billion over four years - starting 1 July 2014. Seeing as this measure has yet to pass the Budget, how much money has the Government forgone because of their inability to get this measure through the Parliament?

**Answer:**

The measure 'Limit Family Tax Benefit Part B to families with children under six years of age' was expected to save \$1.89 billion over the forward estimates. There has been no substantial change to the financial impact as the intended start date is 1 July 2015.
