Senator Brown asked:

a. How many people under the age of 65 have an NDIS plan or are completing the planning process in each of the launch sites?

b. How many of these are under 50 years?

c. How many of these are aged 50-54 years?

Answer:

As at 30 September 2014, there were three additional trial sites active. There were 10,939 people who had been found eligible for the NDIS. Of these, 9,277 were aged 0-49 years, 532 were aged 50-54 years, 1,042 were aged 55-64 years and 88 were aged 65 years and over.

The split of these participants across trial sites is shown in the table below.
