#### Senator Brown asked:

- a. How many people under the age of 65 were in residential aged care in each of the launch sites on 1 July 2013?
- b. How many of these are under 50 years?
- c. How many of these are aged 50-54 years?

#### **Answer:**

Due to the eligibility requirements in the trial sites not all people under the age of 65 in those sites would have been eligible for the NDIS. For example, on 1 July 2013, the NDIS began in Tasmania for young people aged 15-24.
