The average asset value (50 per cent of the combined assets of the couple for partnered pensioners) for the top 10 per cent of part pensioners when ranked by asset value is \$497,844 as at June 2014. The average asset value for the top 10 per cent of part pensioners when ranked by asset value is broken down by payment type:
 - Age Pension (\$497,623);
 - Carer Payment (\$495,308);
 - Disability Support Pension (\$507,109);
 - Wife (Age) Pension (\$443,718); and
 - Wife (DSP) Pension (\$464,237).
