Senator Moore asked:

Has the Department received any representations from Carers Australia or other carer organisations about the changes to the indexation of pensions announced in the 2014 Budget? If so, what organisations? Were any made through other consultations or meetings?

Answer:

Carers Australia attended Department of Social Services Budget Measures 2014 implementation stakeholder consultations in June 2014. While no verbatim records were made of these consultations, indexation arrangements were raised by Carers Australia at the meeting on 18 June 2014.

Carers Australia and a number of state and territory carer associations (list attached) also attended roundtable consultations with the Welfare Reform Reference Group in all capital cities and Cairns, in July-August 2014. While no verbatim records were made of these consultations, indexation arrangements were discussed at the meetings, which could have included representations by Carers Australia and other carer associations.

Carers Australia and Carers New South Wales provided submissions in August 2014 in response to the Welfare Reform Reference Group's Interim Report, which included their views on pension indexation.

The Department is aware of Carer Australia's submission to the Standing Committee on Community Affairs inquiry into the Social Services and other Legislation (2014 Budget measures) Amendment Bills No. 1 and No. 2, which includes commentary on the measure to index pensions by CPI only.
