Question:

a) Please outline how many applications were made for the Severe Behaviour Response Teams?

b) How many of those were for provision of a national program versus for state by state delivery

c) Was the Department specifically directed NOT to discuss the SBRT in Senate Estimates, even though it was clear the decision had been made at the time of the hearing?

Answer:

- a) The Department of Social Services received 13 applications for the Severe Behaviour Response Teams Phase 1, with one application ruled as ineligible resulting in 12 applications progressing to assessment.
- b) Two applications were for provision of a national programme, all others were for a smaller scope of coverage.
- c) The decision to announce the successful provider was a matter for the Government.
