No, the Department of Health has not announced the successful applicants to provide Partners in Culturally Appropriate Care in Western Australia. The Department is close to finalising the process to appoint a provider. An announcement will be made once a funding agreement is in place

On 27 April 2015, the Government announced a further, two-year commitment to all funded organisations under the Partners in Culturally Appropriate Care (PICAC) Programme to 30 June 2017.
