Senator Rachel Siewert asked:

Is the Government monitoring how many people moved off DSP onto Newstart now have medical exemptions from mutual obligation requirements?a) If so, how many have exemptions?b) If not, why not?

Answer:

The Department regularly monitors payment recipient data and trends, and the impact of policy change, including the under 35s review of Disability Support Pension (DSP).

 a) As at the end of September 2016, there were 2,735 recipients on Newstart Allowance (NSA) who had previously transferred from DSP to NSA as a result of the under 35s review of DSP. Of these, 199 recipients (or 7 per cent) had a medical exemption from Mutual Obligation requirements.
