- 1. Can you provide an update on the development of the Integrated Plan for Carer Support Services, has the advisory group delivered their final Service Concept and proposed service delivery model to Government?
- a) If so, when was this provided to the Government?
- b) If not, when is it expected to be delivered?
- 2. When did work on the development of the Integrated Plan for Carer Support Services commence?
- 3. What was the timeframe for the development of the Plan?
- 4. Please provide a detailed summary of consultations undertaken to date to inform the development of the Plan including dates, locations, parties involved and a breakdown the costs incurred by the Department?
- 5. What will be the process to take this work forward?
- a) What is the expected implementation timeframe?
- b) Is there any budgetary allocation for the implementation of the Plan?
- 6. In the interim what is the current status of funding for all the Carer Support Programmes funded by the Department of Social Services? Do any of these programmes have funding agreements that are due to finish this calendar year? Or this financial year? If so for each programme please provide:
- a) the name of each funded service provider
- b) the length of the current funding agreements
- c) the funding amount for each service
- d) the funding location for each service
- e) the total quantum of funding for each programme
- 7. In relation to the Carer Support Programmes funded by the Department of Social Services which are listed in the Annex of the draft Service Concept, could you provide a table outlining the funding allocation over each of the out years and confirm how long agreements are in place for each of the programmes?

Answer:

- 1. The draft Service Concept for the design of a new integrated carer support service system underwent public consultation from 2 May to 16 June 2016. A summary report on the Public Consultation was provided to Government in August 2016 and is available at www.dss.gov.au/disability-and-carers/programmes-services/for-carers/integrated-plan-for-carer-support-services
- a) The draft Service Delivery Model was provided to Government in October 2016. It was publically released on 6 November 2016 and is currently undergoing public consultation until 16 December 2016.
- b) Following feedback from the public consultation, the draft Service Delivery Model will be revised and form the basis of a proposal to be provided to Government.

- 2. Development of the Plan commenced in May 2015.
- 3. The timeframe for completion of Stage One of the Plan, Carer Gateway, was December 2015, which was achieved. The next phase of the Plan co-design of a future integrated carer support service system is on track to be provided to Government by early 2017.
- 4. A detailed summary of consultation to date is provided at **Attachment A**.

Consultation expenses:

- 2015-16 \$116,500.
- 2016-17 \$24,000 (as at 31 October 2016).
- 5. The draft Service Delivery Model is currently undergoing a public consultation process. The outcomes of the public consultation process will help inform a proposal for Government consideration.
 - a) The commencement of any future carer support service is subject to a future decision of Government.
 - b) No.
- 6. A number DSS carer support programs were previously due to cease on 30 June 2017. These include: Commonwealth Respite and Carelink Centres, National Carer Counselling Program, Carer Information and Support Service, Consumer Directed Respite Care, Counselling, Support, Information and Advocacy: Carer Support and Dementia Education and Training for Carers. The Government recently decided to extend these programs for a further 12 months to 30 June 2018.

The Young Carer Bursary Program is funded to 31 December 2017.

Mental Health Respite: Carer Support, Respite Support, Respite Support for Carers of Young People with a Severe or Profound Disability, and the Young Carers Program are currently funded until 30 June 2019. MyTime is funded until 30 June 2020.

Carers and Work and Dementia and Aged Care Service Grants (former Aged Care Service Improvement and Healthy Ageing Grants) are due to cease by 30 June 2017. Dementia and Aged Care Service Grants are time-limited project grants due to finish this financial year. Details on sub questions 6(a)-(e) for these two programs are provided at **Attachment B**.

7. Indicative funding details are provided at **Attachment C**.
