Question:

Senator POLLEY: The decision to progress on outsourcing the MBS and the PBS claims and payments must have come from cabinet. Is that correct? Is that your understanding? Mr Bowles: Not necessarily. Again, I would have to take it on notice because it is before my time, but it was a decision of the 2014-15 budget to look at an assessment of the claims and payments system for Medicare and to come up with a solution. That was way back in 2014, as we said, and a range of other things have happened since that time.

Answer:

There has never been a decision to outsource the MBS and PBS claims and payments. In the 2014-15 Budget the Government provided funding for the Department of Health to develop a proposal in consultation with the Department of Human Services to market test the delivery of a commercially integrated health payment system.
