Answer:

Funding allocated to individual Primary Health Networks (PHNs) for the PHN Drug and Alcohol Treatment Program, in 2016-17, is as at Attachment A.

All PHN Drug and Alcohol Treatment Activity Work Plans have been approved. All PHNs are now able to commence commissioning activities and enter into contracts with drug and alcohol treatment service providers and some are already providing services.
